

This program was developed after extensive consultations with teachers, scholars, parents, educators, and psychologists. It aims to prepare children to become strong, confident, and socially responsible individuals.

**SKILLS:** The 5 most essential skills and competencies required in today's world include:

**ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES:** This encompasses the recognition of 5 major rights and responsibilities mandatory upon individuals. These include:

## Quran and Sunnah Program (QSP)

Quran and Sunnah Program (QSP) offers Quranic education to students across Pakistan, in both government and private schools. Millions of students benefit from our Nazirah and Fahm-ul-Quran courses, designed using Total Physical Interaction's innovative teaching method. It empowers many to connect deeply with the Quran.

Quran & Sunnah Program offerings:

#### Nazirah Quran:

This unique curriculum, designed for students from kindergarten to grade 5, helps them read the Quran correctly.

#### • Fahm-ul-Quran:

A comprehensive program for grades 6 to 12, enabling students to understand and translate the Quran.

#### • University-Level Quranic Studies:

A curriculum in Tajweed and Fahm-ul-Quran for university students, spanning three credit hours.

#### • Hifz with Understanding:

A three-year program from classes 6 to 8, allowing students to memorize the Quran while understanding its teachings, along with studying core subjects like Urdu, English, Maths, and Science.

# Community Development Program (CDP)

Pakistan's younger generation faces critical challenges, such as a lack of leadership, entrepreneurship, and community spirit. To address these, Character Education Foundation (CEF) has introduced the Community Development Program (CDP). This initiative enhances the impact of our Quran and Sunnah Program (QSP) and Character Building Program (CBP). The program includes:

#### Community Development Initiative (CDI)

CEF collaborates with local stakeholders to launch impactful community projects tailored to regional needs. CDI focuses on empowering individuals and fostering long-term community growth.

• CLE Education: The Citizenship, Leadership, and Entrepreneurship (CLE) program builds strong communities by engaging students in leadership and entrepreneurial activities. Initially operating in AJ&K and Murree, this initiative equips localities with tools for social, moral & economic growth through dedicated CEF members.

• **OSP Character Building:** Supporting orphan children, this program focuses on character building and development for students from primary to high school, in collaboration with the Zakat Foundation of America.

#### **Educational Advancement Initiative (EAI)**

EAI bridges academic gaps by equipping students with essential 21st-century skills. The program includes:

• Concept Mastery Initiative (CMI): Designed for Hifz students, CMI ensures mastery of Maths, Science, English, and Urdu with no homework and minimal study time.

• Enhancing Quality Education: Under this program, currently in Jhelum, a 10-year partnership with the education department focuses on mentoring government school teachers for continuous growth.

• Career Counselling: This program helps students identify their strengths for informed career choices. Next year, it aims to reach 10 million students nationwide. CDP is building strong, self-reliant communities and shaping brighter futures.



# Youth Leadership Program (YLP)

Youth Leadership Program (YLP) by Character Education Foundation (CEF) engages university students to develop leadership skills for future roles in family and society. Through Quranic education courses, aligned with Higher Education Commission guidelines, and leadership training, YLP aims to shape Pakistan's future leaders.

We plan to establish Character Education Societies in universities to provide platforms for personal growth and character-building activities. Additionally, dynamic outdoor engagement programs offer physical leadership training and immersive sessions for intellectual development.

#### • Outdoor Engagement Campaigns



Our outdoor engagement campaigns are conducted under Youth Impact (YI), a leader in youth leadership development for over a decade that is now part of CEF. These programs help students discover their inner strength, enhance problem-solving abilities, build community, and foster empathy. By combining adventure-based learning and hands-on experiences, YI empowers young leaders to grow personally and contribute positively to their communities.

# Mentor Development Program (MDP)

Character Education Foundation (CEF) is committed to empowering educators through its Mentor Development Program (MDP). This program aims to transform parents and teachers into exceptional mentors by providing specialized training. Each participant is guided through transitioning from a traditional educator (mudarris) to an effective instructor (muallim) and ultimately to an inspiring mentor (murabbi). MDP plays a key role in CEF's mission to foster holistic development in the younger generation.

#### **Our Specialized Courses:**

#### • Tajweed-ul-Quran:

This course helps master Quranic recitation using Total Physical Interaction (TPI) and phonics methods, enhancing recitation skills.

#### • Fahm-ul-Quran:

A 52-hour course that covers 85 percent of Quranic vocabulary and grammar, empowering participants to understand and apply Quranic wisdom.

#### • Parenting Course:

A 20-lesson course designed to nurture children's physical, emotional, and spiritual development.

#### • Seerah Course:

A 24-lesson course exploring the life of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) to instill courage, compassion, and leadership in personal and family life.

#### Meaningful Life:

A course focused on life visioning, role balancing, and faith to create a purposeful and balanced life.

#### • Successful Marital Life:

This course covers Islamic principles for building a strong, compassionate, and faith-centered marriage.

#### **Specialized Supporting Institutions:**

To support MDP, specialized institutions have been established across Pakistan for equipping teachers and parents to become effective mentors.



### **CEF Institutions**

Our dedicated institutions empower parents and teachers to transition from traditional educators to impactful mentors for young generations. By fostering mentorship, we enhance the developmental journey of our young generation, guiding them towards becoming well-rounded individuals.

#### Character Education Academies (CEA):

Ten academies are operational at the district level, providing training for teachers in Nazirah Quran, Fahm-ul-Quran, and the character-building of our young generation. Specially designed short courses are also offered to transform teachers into mentors, equipping them with the skills to guide and inspire students.

#### • Character Education Homes (CEH):

Established in rural areas, 25 homes are already providing support to mothers and women. These centers offer courses on Tajweed-ul-Quran, Fahm-ul-Quran, parenting for character building of our young generation, purposeful living, seerah, and successful marital life. Women continue their personal growth through life-long learning circles. CEF plans to establish 45,246 homes across rural Pakistan.

#### • Character Education Institutes (CEI):

Tailored for urban women, eight institutes have been established in cities like Karachi, Lahore, and Islamabad. Courses focus on Tajweed-ul-Quran, Fahm-ul-Quran, parenting for character building of our young generation, purposeful living, and successful marital life. CEF plans to expand this initiative by establishing 1,800 institutes nationwide.
